

AIRBRUSH MAKE-UP FAQ'S

What is Airbrush Makeup?

Airbrush make-up is a professional makeup application technique, utilizing compressed air through an "airbrush gun" to apply a fine mist of water resistant, oil free, mineral and vitamin enriched makeup onto the skin. Airbrushing is a specialized makeup application that once was used only by makeup artists for TV celebrities and for those on professional photo shoots. Now, airbrush makeup is a service that has been made available to everyone for special occasions, such as weddings and photo sessions. Airbrush make-up is...

- Oil-free
- Lightweight in look and feel
- Long-wearing and transfer resistant
- Non-comedogenic, meaning it won't clog pores or aggravate acne
- An excellent way to cover scars or tattoos
- Gentle on sensitive skin
- Offered in a full color range, so skin tones can be matched perfectly.

Is airbrush make-up safe?

Yes, airbrush make-up is very safe. In fact, airbrush make-up is more hygienic than traditional make-up application, because it is applied without the use of applicator sponges or brushes, which harbor and transfer bacteria. When make-up is applied by an airbrush, it sits on the surface of the skin, rather than being pressed down into pores, giving a light and natural feel and allowing the skin to breathe. As a result, blemishes and adverse skin reactions are minimized.

Is airbrush make-up right for everyone?

Airbrush make-up is suitable for persons of all ages, any skin color, type, and condition. The make-up is hypoallergenic and fragrance free. In fact, airbrush make-up is the only make-up that is suitable for the new "HD" (High Definition) standard in television and photography.

How does airbrush make-up feel?

Airbrush make-up is exceptionally lightweight, natural looking, and feels unnoticeable when worn.

What are the benefits of airbrush make-up?

Airbrush make-up provides flawless coverage, minimizing skin imperfections and giving skin a beautiful natural finish. Airbrush makeup is hypoallergenic, non-comedogenic, meaning it won't clog pores, and is water and smudge resistant, lasting for up to twelve hours or more. Lastly, you never have to worry about sanitation of application tools, such as brushes or wands, since nothing touches the skin during application.

Can airbrush make-up cover tan lines, acne, scars, tattoos, or other skin imperfections?

Yes, airbrush makeup may be used almost anywhere on the body to camouflage skin imperfections, including tattoos, scars, stretch marks, areas with hyper-/hypo-pigmentation, including those associated with Vitiligo. Although it will cover up most discoloration due to acne, it may not camouflage bumps or deep scars. Airbrush make-up will hide most tan lines, however, using airbrush make-up in areas in constant contact with clothing or areas that may rub is not recommended.

When should I get airbrush makeup?

Although you can have airbrush make-up applied whenever and as frequently as you like, most people choose airbrush make-up application for special events such as weddings, proms, portrait sessions, birthday parties, or any big celebration in which you want to look your very best. It is ideal for these events, as airbrush makeup has a much longer wear-life than traditional makeup. Airbrush make-up can endure the long process of getting ready a big event, which may begin early in the morning, although your event may not be until later in the evening. From application to removal, airbrush make-up appears freshly applied with minimal fatigue, unlike traditional make-up that seems to magically wear off half way through the day.

Will airbrush makeup come off if I cry or sweat?

Whether you cry or sweat, airbrush makeup will stay in place. By simply taking a tissue and blotting the wet area, the wetness will be lifted and the makeup will stay in place. In the heat of the summer, airbrush makeup will stay looking the same as it did when it was applied. Of course, airbrush make-up is not permanent, and measures should be taken to minimize excessive heat and moisture.

Are touch-ups necessary?

Touch-ups are not usually necessary, however, depending on your skin type and environmental factors, such as the weather, minimal touch-ups may be required. When airbrush make-up is worn in hot humid environments, or when worn by individuals with extremely oily skin, the face may become somewhat shiny throughout the course of the day. Do not use traditional make-up to do touch-ups. In the event a touch-up is needed, your esthetician will provide you instruction on what product(s) to use.

How do I remove airbrushed makeup?

Airbrushed make-up will stay bright and luminous for many hours, but when you're ready to remove it, simply use a bit of soap and water on a soft cloth to gently scrub your face clean. Baby shampoo is recommended because it won't irritate the eyes or delicate skin around them.
